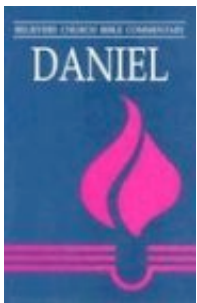

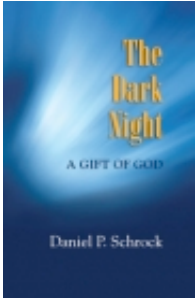

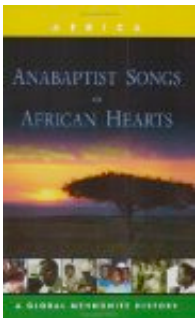
The Dark Night: A Gift of God by Daniel P. Schrock Apr 21, 06:07 PM
